One weighed 5lbs. 1oz. and the other weighed 3lbs. Raul DeLatorre (top right) was lucky enough to catch this tagged 2lbs. trout. He won a new spinning reel!

Bryan Lazarescu (bottom left) caught the biggest trout of the week weighing in at 5lbs. 15oz. He caught it on green Powerbait in lake 4.
