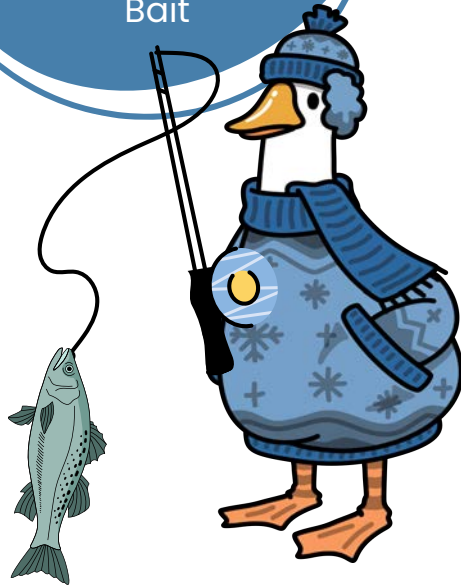

Camping Hacks

A “Camping Hack” is a clever, simple shortcut or DIY trick that makes camping easier, more efficient, or more fun.

Homemade Tank Cleaner

Mix a cup of dish soap and ½ cup of Calgon water softener to create an effective, cheap waste tank cleaner.

Keep Addresses and Contact Numbers Within Sight

Get a dry-erase board and stick it somewhere convenient. Write down the name, site number, phone number, and address of any campground when you arrive. In case of an emergency, having this information available for paramedics or emergency personnel will help them get to you faster.

You can also write convenient information like the WiFi password on the dry erase board as well.

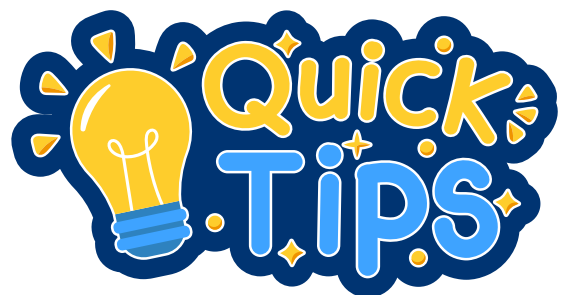
Hold Black Out Curtains in Place With Velcro

Add a small square of Velcro to the backs of your curtains, and to the spot on your wall where you want the curtains to stay in place. This keeps the curtains from falling open and letting the sunshine in!

Camper Safety



Electric bikes & scooters

If you or your kiddos have an E bike or E scooter, please be mindful of your speed and the speed of your kiddos. The posted speed limit of 15 mph is for all vehicles including Electric bikes/scooters.

Leash please

Please keep your fur babies on a leash. Not only because of wild animals that visit periodically, but for the safety of your your pet and neighboring campers.



As always...

Our campground is situated in an area of wildlife habitat. If you see a coyote, you should exhibit caution, as they may be desperate for food and will attempt to get close if there is food nearby. If you are approached by a coyote, shout, wave your arms, and do what you can to make yourself appear bigger. If you are walking a small pet, pick it up. If you are walking a larger pet, keep it close to your side.

Campground FAQs



- Do campers need to purchase a fishing permit?
 - Yes, campers will need a permit. You can purchase a permit at the General Store, Gate house, or Park Ranger.
- How late are campers able to fish in Lake 6 and 7?
 - Campers may fish until 11 PM.
- Do we have to bring our own fire pit?
 - Yes, please bring your fire pit, there are no ground fires allowed.
- Can we set-up a tent on our RV site?
 - No, there is only one camping unit per site. If you wish to set-up additional camping units you can reserve one of our designated tent sites.
- What time is checkout?
 - 11:00AM is checkout for campers, Cabin guest's checkout time is 10:30AM.
- Where is the Campground Bark Park located?
 - The Bark Park is located in the very north west corner of the Campground.
- Can we use an inflatable pool?
 - No, due to safety issues, inflatable pools are not allowed.
- What time is quiet time?
 - 9:00PM is Campground quiet time.
- What time does my fire have to be out?
 - Please have your fire extinguished by 10:00PM
- How many people are allowed on my campsite?
 - Campers can have a maximum of 6 people on each site.
- Can we hang up a hammock?
 - No. Hammocks can be harmful to trees, as well as other safety issues.
